MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Vanguard will soon complete fifty-four years of support for the Albany Symphony and the level of that support has not diminished during the 2016-2017 season. In addition to providing services to the ASO staff, we have worked throughout the season to raise funds that will become part of Vanguard's annual gift to the Symphony. Events organized by Vanguard members have included a trip to SPAC on August 18, the Fall Luncheon/Fashion Show on October 18, and the bus trip to the Culinary Institute of America and Val-Kill on December 12. To the profits from these traditional events we are fortunate to be able to add income from a second annual shopping day at Talbot's of Stuyvesant Plaza on November 20, when the store gave Vanguard ten percent of the sales during a three-hour period.

Income from these early events is only a small part of what we hope to give to the Symphony at our Annual Meeting in June. The largest portion of the annual gift will come from profits made at the Showhouse, which is described in this issue of the Newsletter. I hope that members and other supporters will contribute to the success of the Showhouse by telling friends and acquaintances how they can help the Symphony while having a pleasant outing and getting ideas for enhancing their homes.

Vanguard is happy to announce that next season will have a new fundraiser -- a golf tournament on August 28 at the Albany Country Club. Please see Page 4 for more information.

I am grateful to everyone who attended Vanguard's earlier events. Now, as we approach the end of the season, I want to encourage all lovers of the Albany Symphony to contribute to this year's fundraising by supporting the Showhouse and to continue that support as we move into a new year!

SHOWHOUSE 2017

The articles in this issue of the Newsletter should give readers many reasons to wish to see Vanguard's thirty-seventh annual Showhouse. As in previous years there will be spaces beautifully transformed by designers and decorative artists. Visitors will again be able to have a delicious lunch in the Café and to make tax-free purchases of Showhouse furnishings and accessories and of fine craft items in the Boutique. There will be the usual variety of special events including designer-led tours, seminars on design, and programs on history of the house.

To those who visited past Vanguard Showhouses, the beautiful rooms, designer tours, shopping opportunities and special events will seem familiar. Showhouse 2017, however, offers an experience that was not available in those of the past—a view of a home that has evolved in an unusual way. This year's house, unlike those seen in previous Showhouses, does not come from a single period. The house began as a home in another community, and its interior was later taken apart so that it could be rebuilt in its present location. The spaces in it, therefore, have architectural styles that came from different periods of its 200 year history. The difference in styles does not cause the newer rooms of the house to clash with the older ones. The Showhouse designers, who have shown in the past how well they can adapt their plans to the spaces they are given, can be counted on to complete their rooms in ways that are in harmony with the spaces in which they work and with the spaces that are nearby.

Showhouse 2017 will be offering visitors something new by showing ways of working with rooms from different periods and by giving them ideas for beautifying both old and new spaces in their own homes.


SAVE THE DATE - APRIL 2, 2017
